

Make your voice heard – Register & Vote!

To register to vote, you must be:	This means:
A citizen of the United States;	I was born here or became a citizen by going through a process called “naturalization.”
A legal resident of Washington state at least 30 days before election day;	I have a permanent address in the state.
At least 18 years old by election day;	I can’t vote until I’m 18. I can sign up when I’m 16 or 17, though!
Not under supervision by the Department of Corrections because of a felony conviction.	I can register and vote if I am not in prison or under community supervision.

Key dates for November 3, Presidential election

- **Register online:** deadline - Monday, October 26, 2020
- **Update an existing voter registration** with a new name or address: deadline - Monday, October 26, 2020
- **Register in person:** deadline - Tuesday, November 3, 2020
- **Vote in person:** at a county voting center beginning October 16 to November 3, 2020
- **Vote by mail:** suggest at least 1 week before Election Day.
 - **Official drop box (at Crossroads Shopping Center, outside south entrance):** deposit by 8pm, November 3, 2020
 - **U.S. post office (USPS):** must be postmarked November 3, 2020

No stamp is required for official drop box or USPS mail
